Registration is provided on a first come, first served basis.

The Salvation Army will be taking applications for Angel Tree assistance for families with children birth to 14 years of age (at Christmas) and seniors 62 and up. All applications are taken through a face-to-face interview with the parent or legal guardian, using the following information:

- ⇒ Valid state issued photo ID for person applying
- ⇒ Proof of residence in Franklin or Anderson County (current lease preferred)
- ⇒ Proof of Income—all current household income (August or September pay stubs, SNAP, KTAP, Social Security Disability eligibility letter, child support, other benefits, other income)
- ⇒ Proof of Expenses—all current monthly bills (rent, utility, car, childcare, other bills)
- ⇒ Birth Certificate for each child or legal guardianship/custody documents

All documentation must be present to hold an interview.

The registration process will proceed smoothly if you have all of the above information as well as know your children's clothing and shoes sizes and (3) gift wishes.
