Welcome Home, Dr. Houston Barber and Family

After a lengthy search involving more than 30 applicants, the Frankfort Independent Board of Education has hired Dr. Houston Barber to be the new superintendent. Dr. Barber began with the school district July 30.

Houston is well known to the residents of South Frankfort. He grew up on Conway Street and is a 1994 graduate of Frankfort High School. He is remembered as a state champion track and cross country athlete, setting the state high school record in 1994 for the 1600 meter.

He was previously principal of Shawnee and Fern Creek High School, where he is credited with moving Fern Creek in three years from a persistently low performing school to being named one of the best high schools in the US by US News and World Report. He has earned a statewide reputation as one of Kentucky's leading young educators and there is great excitement in the district as he begins his work.

He has recently made an offer to purchase a house in South Frankfort and plans to move his family in November. Family members are wife Darra, sons McLain and Preston, and daughter Kenzie. McLain and Kenzie are enrolled at Second Street School.
