

**South Frankfort Neighborhood Association
(SFNA) Randy Bacon Memorial
Scholarship**

The SFNA, with input from board members from The Kings Center, raises funds for awarding one or more scholarships to Frankfort Independent School (FIS) student(s) living in South Frankfort in honor of long-time SFNA board member, resident, and community activist Randy Bacon.

The award is for scholarship, leadership, and service in school, church, and community in South Frankfort. To receive the scholarship, a student must:

- Be enrolled in the FIS district.
- Be living within the boundaries of South Frankfort as defined by SFNA bylaws.
- Be on track to graduate within the current school year.
- Have a 2.0, or above, cumulative GPA on their mid-term report card.
- Submit the completed application prior to the deadline of **April 1**.

Applications are judged anonymously in the following areas:

- Student essay on “Why I need and deserve this scholarship;”
- Scholastics, extra-curricular activities, and community service;
- Letter of recommendation; and
- Financial need.

Additional information regarding the scholarship process:

- Applicant names, addresses, and identifying information are hidden from judges.
- Scholarship winners are notified with a phone call and/or follow-up letter. Those who did not receive a scholarship are not notified. Announcements are also made on SNFA website, social media, and other outlets.
- Scholarship winner(s) are invited to attend an SFNA quarterly meeting and introduce themselves.
- Scholarship(s) may be used towards college, trade, or vocational school tuition. The scholarship amount will be determined by SFNA fundraisers throughout the year, and based on available funds. The scholarship is non-renewable (a one-time award).
- The SFNA treasurer will provide a check directly to the post-secondary education institution.

1. Essay
 - a. In 500 words or less, please explain "Why I need and deserve this scholarship."
2. Academic information
 - a. Academic honors, awards, etc.
 - b. Extra-curricular activities
 - c. Most recent report card or transcript
3. Community service
 - a. List community projects and the amount of service hours that exemplify your leadership and citizenship in the community. This service must have occurred during high school and be **voluntary** (not resultant from religious, school, legal) or similar mandate).
4. Letter of recommendation
 - a. From an a non-family member, such as a teacher, clergy, or neighbor.
 - b. Ask the writer to **not** use your name or family information in the letter.
5. Proof of financial need
 - a. Letter from FIS guidance counselor or other administrator attesting to applicant's qualification for "free and reduced lunch" or other district-recognized need-based status.
